How to change your site, whenever you like

You never have to come back to us to change a word. Pick whichever way suits you.

1. Claude Code (recommended for everyone)

The easiest way by far, and no coding needed. Open Claude Code in your browser at claude.ai/code, or use the Code tab in the Claude desktop app. The first time only, it asks to connect to GitHub: approve that, then pick your site's repository, the one named `outrightsite` followed by your site name. That one-time connection lets Claude Code read your site's built-in caretaker guide (the `CLAUDE.md` file) so it knows how to change your site safely. After that, just ask for what you want in plain English. Claude makes the change and, once you approve it, publishes it live, usually in a minute or two. Claude Code runs on a small subscription you can start when you want to make changes and cancel any time.

2. Edit it yourself on GitHub (intermediate)

Sign in to your own GitHub account and edit the content files directly. Change the wording or details, save, and your site rebuilds and goes live on its own, usually in a minute or two. This route is for the more confident. Editing the wrong file can break how your site works, so it is not the best place to start.

3. Hand it to a developer (premium)

It is clean, standard code in your own GitHub, with the caretaker guide included, so any web developer can pick it up and carry on. Developers charge for their time, so this is the costliest route, but the choice is always yours. You are never tied to us.

Our honest tip: use Claude Code.

It is the simplest route, and it quietly teaches you a real, repeatable skill. Once you have changed your own site a few times, that know-how is yours for life and works on any project, not just this one.

Where is my caretaker pack? It is the file named `CLAUDE.md` in your GitHub repo, and you can also download it from your handover page. Keep a copy somewhere handy, it is the key to editing your site.

Easy changes you can make

- Update your opening hours or phone number
- Add a new service or change your prices
- Swap in your own photographs
- Add real customer reviews as they come in
